Parking Instructions and Other Information

Arrival/parking - begins on Sunday April 23rd at 8:00 am; please be in and parked no later than 2:00 pm.

****Please note:** Your paid reservation will be verified at the entry gate and a parking person(s) will escort you to your parking space. If you do not have a verifiable paid reservation, you will need to park outside the gate and go to the WARE office to register and pay.

****BootCamp Attendees:** Your reservation should include arrival on Friday so that you may attend the class early Saturday morning; a parking person(s) will escort you to your parking space. If you do not have a verifiable paid reservation, you will need to park outside the gate and go the WARE office to register and pay.

Disabled Parking : Upon arrival, please display your disabled parking placard or other disabled identification in the driver's side window; you will be escorted to the disabled parking area.

Towed: Please unhitch as you pull into the staging area located in front of the North Gate. A ride back to retrieve your towed will be provided if you don't have a second driver for the towed.

Early Arrivals and Late Leavers: There is an additional parking fee for early arrivals and late leavers before and after the WARE. The fee must be paid in advance; please indicate early and/or late dates and include the fee of \$30.00 per night with your rally registration. Early arrivals, please be in and parked by 12 noon.

Parking near/with friends: We will do our best to accommodate requests to park near and/or with friends. **"Parties" of up to 3** should make prior arrangements to arrive together with ribbons of the same color tied to the driver's side mirror. It would also be a good idea to give the Parking Coordinator, Dick Reed, a call at (530) 906-0783 or email dickreed@mycci.net to give him the names in your "party". If you have **more than 3 in your "party"** and you want to park together, you need to contact Parking Coordinator, Dick Reed, at (530) 906-0783 or email dickreed@mycci.net to let him know how many rigs will be in your "party".

DIRECTIONS TO THE YUBA-SUTTER FAIRGROUNDS YUBA CITY, CALIFORNIA

Traveling North past Sacramento Area on I-5, Take HWY 70 north.

HWY 70: Ahead 13 miles, take HWY 99 north.

HWY 99: Ahead 21 miles, Turn RIGHT on Franklin Avenue.

NORTH Ahead 2 miles on Franklin Avenue.

Turn LEFT onto Wilber Avenue.

Turn RIGHT on C Street.

Go one block, Enter Parking Gate on the RIGHT.

Traveling South on I-5, Take HWY 20 east at Williams.

HWY 20: Coming into Yuba, City, Turn RIGHT on HWY 99

WEST Turn LEFT on Franklin (third light)

Ahead 2 miles on Franklin Avenue.

Turn LEFT onto Wilber Avenue.

Go two blocks. Turn RIGHT on C Street.

Go one block, Enter Parking Gate on the RIGHT.

Traveling West from Grass Valley Area

HWY 20: Coming into Marysville, Take HWY 20 towards Yuba City.

WEST Ahead 1.4 miles on HWY 20, Turn LEFT onto Shasta Street.

Go two blocks. Turn LEFT on C Street.

Go one block, Enter Parking Gate on the RIGHT.

Traveling South from Chico Area

HWY 99: Coming into Yuba City, continue past HWY 20.

SOUTH Turn LEFT at Franklin Avenue (third light).

Turn LEFT onto Wilber Avenue.

Turn RIGHT on C Street.

Go one block, Enter Parking Gate on the RIGHT.

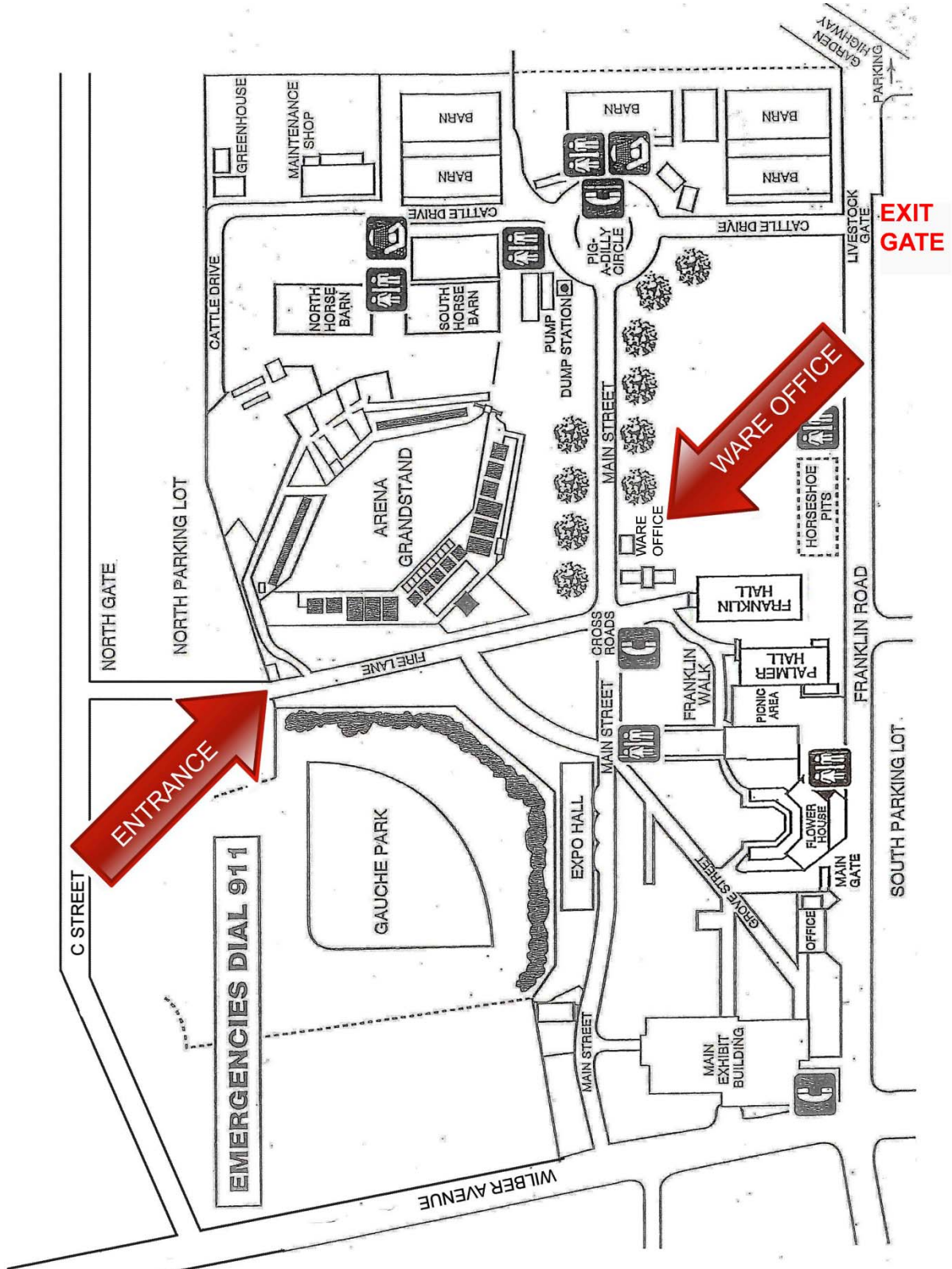
Traveling South from Oroville Area

HWY 70: Coming into Marysville, take HWY 20 towards Yuba City.

SOUTH Ahead 1.4 miles on HWY 20, Turn LEFT onto Shasta Street.

Go two blocks. Turn LEFT on C Street.

Go one block, Enter Parking Gate on the RIGHT.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

KNOW WHERE YOU ARE PARKED in relationship to the Livestock Gate; please see fairgrounds map.

Dial 911.....tell the 911 operator your emergency and that you are at the Yuba Sutter Fairgrounds, 442 Franklin Ave, Yuba City, CA. If possible, stay on phone with emergency personnel until help arrives.

Turn **ALL** your lights on: *headlights, interior and hazard flasher lights*.
Your rig will be hard to locate among the many on the grounds, especially at night.

Notify Art Fennell @ (503) 930-5431 in order to activate staff to meet the rescue first responders and/or the Fire Department at the Livestock Gate to escort and guide them to your area.

To exit the fairgrounds: use the Livestock Gate; it is “dummy-locked” at 9:00 pm each night; chain is secured with lock, but lock is not latched.
